AIR CONDITIONING

Use air-conditioning remote control to adjust individual room temperature and functions. For any assistance with the air-conditioning & remote please see reception. Please keep the temperature above 20c as the compressor will freeze up with the humidity.

BATHROOM AMENITIES

Your bathroom is stocked with amenities for your convenience. These items will be replenished with your next service.

Your bathroom includes a hair dryer.

If you need any additional bathroom items, please contact reception and they will be provided at no charge.

COTS AND HIGH CHAIRS

Cots and high chairs are available for your convenience. Please contact reception during open hours to arrange this. **Charges apply, see Schedule of Fees.**

LAUNDRY AND IRONING FACILITIES

Each apartment has a laundry room with laundry and ironing facilities available inside.

Please remember to switch off the iron after use.

MAIL

Mail may be left at reception for collection and posting. Alternatively, there is a post office located 3 minutes away via car at the Valley Shopping Centre (Shop 4B/184 Goondoon St, Gladstone Central).

PETS

Assistance animals are permitted into accommodation areas and on the premises, though we do ask that you please inform reception of the presence of a service dog. It is the policy of this property that all other pets are NOT permitted in accommodation.

TEA AND COFFEE

Your apartment is stocked with coffee, tea bags, sugar, and long life milk. These items will be replenished with your next service.

Any additional stocks you may require can be obtained from reception.

WI-FI

Free Wi-Fi has been installed in each room. To connect to our secured network, login details will be provided in your welcome letter.

TELEVISION

The LCD television receives all Free-to-air stations.

SERVICING

Daily Service/Check includes, check for rubbish, pull up bedding, replace obviously soiled towels if on the floor and general check of the room.

Servicing is not available on Saturday and Sunday.

A full service is done weekly for longer stays. That includes: change sheets, clean bathroom, clean kitchen if applicable – check of the oven, vacuum ,mop floors, replace towels, bathmat, hand towel & face washer, replace tea towel and cloth and top up all guest amenities.

PARKING

Free onsite parking subject to availability. Parking at your own risk.

NO SMOKING

Our property is NON SMOKING. Please refrain from smoking in your room, on the balconies and anywhere within the property. Evidence of smoking will incur a fee, see Schedule of Fees.



NOISE

We ask that you respect other guests by limiting the amount of noise made after 9:00PM, any disturbances that require management involvement may have a charge imposed. Whilst we encourage guests to enjoy themselves, we advise there is a strict No Party Policy. Failure to comply will incur a fee, see Schedule of Fees.

KEYS

KEYS to the apartment must be returned to reception or placed in the key box situated before the secure gate on departure. A replacement fee shall be charged to the guest account should they not be returned or damaged beyond use. See Schedule of Fees for details.

DAMAGE & LOSS

The person(s) registering as the guest(s) shall be liable for any loss or damage to the appliances, furniture, keycards, fixtures and all fittings in the Apartment. Fair wear and tear excluded.

THEFT

Central Apartment Group shall not be responsible for, or liable to compensate for the loss, theft or damage of personal property on, or brought into the apartment or in the immediate vicinity of the Apartments.

LIABILITY OF PAYMENT

Where guests sign for and on behalf of a business or company, and in the event that the business or company is unable to or refuses to pay any amount due, the Guest(s) shall be liable to pay on demand any amount owing by the business or company under the agreement.

REFUNDS

Full refund of deposits shall only be paid if the Terms and Conditions detailed in the Reservation Confirmation Letter are fully satisfied.

TERM OF STAY CHANGES

Should the term of accommodation be reduced, the registered guest hereby agrees to be liable for the appropriate tariff under the current Schedule of Rates. Refunds may be applied to an early departure (Under Management's Discretion).

NUMBER OF GUESTS

The number of guests in the apartment at any one time shall not exceed the number of guests declared on the Guest Registration Form. Should at any time the number of guests in the apartment exceed the number of guests detailed, Central Apartment Group reserves the right to terminate the reservation immediately, without refund.

FIRE ALARMS

Central Apartment Group has the right to charge for any Fire False alarm if set off by a guest where the Fire Brigade is called out. The Normal fine is \$1,500.00 that will be charged if required. However a minimum of \$400.00 plus GST will be charged to your Credit card after the Fire Brigade call out.

ROOM DEPARTURE

Guests are responsible for the state of the room upon departure. If rooms are found to be in an excessively bad state, the guest acknowledges that Central Apartment Group has the right to charge a cleaning fee to the credit card supplied when making the booking.

EAST SHORES WATER PARK & LOOKOUT

The East Shores Maritime Precinct is Gladstone's newest place to play!

East Shores provides a world-class recreational precinct for Gladstone residents and visitors of all ages to meet, relax, exercise and enjoy the foreshore area.

The parklands include a water play park, waterfront boardwalk, BBQs, a waterfront café, outdoor cinema, boot camp facility, basketball hoops and plenty of green space.



TONDOON BOTANIC GARDENS

The Tondoon Botanic Gardens are home to an impressive species of plants from the Port Curtis Region and Tropical North Queensland. The gardens are set upon an 83 hectare site with a wide variety of flora and fauna.

Officially opened in 1988, the gardens provide local residents and visitors with a place of inspiration, recreation, and relaxation and is a popular place for picnics, cultural and ceremonial events.

Walking trails curve through a variety of rainforest types where plant-aficionados of all fitness levels can amble across the grounds and uncover some rare and endangered species on show.

MOUNT LARCOM

Mount Larcom is both a town and a mountain located roughly 25 minutes west of Gladstone.

The town is known for its welcoming atmosphere and the annual agricultural show, a popular local event.

A challenging trek up to the mountain peak is rewarded with an uninterrupted 360-degree view of the Gladstone Area. Rural lands and the Gladstone Harbour can easily be recognised from the summit, and on a clear day you will see reef islands to the east and Rockhampton to the north.



SPINNAKER PARK

The award winning Spinnaker Park was officially opened in 2001, and has since become the premier recreation area of Gladstone City. Two and a half kilometres of educational walking tracks along the ocean wall through native wetlands and ponds makes the park excellent for walking or riding. The beached cove is wonderful for a dip on a warm day while the barbecue and picnic areas make it a great place to entertain.

The grassy areas of Spinnaker Park are fantastic for barbecues, picnics, birthday parties, events and more. Sheltered seating areas and public amenities are provided for visitor's convenience.



HERON ISLAND

Escape to paradise at Heron Island, a coral cay on the Great Barrier Reef! Explore the vibrant underwater world by snorkeling or diving amidst colourful fish and coral formations. Kayak through crystal-clear waters, relax on pristine beaches, or learn about the island's ecology. Reach your island sanctuary by scenic helicopter flight or ferry from Gladstone Marina, immersing yourself in the beauty of the Great Barrier Reef from the moment your journey begins.



GLADSTONE GOLF CLUB

The Gladstone Golf Club is virtually cut from the forests of the Upper Peninsula. Surrounded by thousands of acres of state forest, the 18-hole championship course is one of the most scenic golf venues in the region.

CURTIS ISLAND NATIONAL PARK

A large island with wind-sheared scrublands, diverse birdlife and pristine beaches, Curtis Island remains one of the hidden secrets of Central Queensland. The parks here offer tranquil ocean vistas and stretches of uninhabited beaches.

Curtis Island is accessible only by boat from the mainland, and there is a regular vehicle and passenger ferry service from Gladstone Marina to the southern end of the island.



LAKE AWOONGA

Whether you're looking for a place to splash, fish or relax, Lake Awoonga is a nature lover's paradise. The Lake is stocked with Barra, Saratoga and Sea Mullet. If you happen to reel in a Mangrove Jack consider yourself lucky as they're a rare find.

There are a range of ways to experience this environmental gem just 30 kilometres from Gladstone; hire a boat or kayak, do a day cruise, or just make the most of the natural surrounds by taking a walk, a dip or lazing under the trees.
